1	STE LTS Supplemental RFI	RFI makes no reference to the STE LT SOW. Was it provided as information only or does the Government want us to provide comments on the SOW?	The SOW that is in Attachment 5 is a standard for this requirement. If Vendor feels a comment is warranted in the SOW go ahead and place a comment. The RFI Supplement Attachment 5 and its technical supplement is meant for response from Vendor on the SOW requirements.
2	Section 2.0 STE LTS Supplemental RFI	RFI states: "the responses shall not exceed two (2) pages for introduction and administration and no more than 15 pages for all engagement types and enabling technologies." If comments on the SOW are required can the Government authorize (4) pages for introduction and administration and no more than (15) pages for all engagement types and enabling technologies? This is required to support the additional information requested.	Any references to the SOW should be covered in the Technical Supplement and does not effect the page count for the other areas. If Vendor needs an introduction to SOW then the Government authorizes the 4 pages.
3	Section 4.3 f Statement of Work (SOW) For Synthetic Training Environment Live Training System (STE-LTS)	The SOW states Soldier Touch Point (STP) 3 occurs on 11-22 April 2022. This applies to Objective 1 placed, dropped, thrown objects. When is the STP for Objective 2 which is Increment 1 Direct Indirect and Counter Defilade for those submitting a solution for Objective 2 under this RFI?"	Soldier Touch Points are set dates coordinated with Ft Hood. Once an agreement is awarded, the Government and vendor will agree on a schedule and appropriate STPs for the prototype effort.
